Table participants offered the following suggestions in response to the question of how the campus community can build upon the success of being a community that welcomes and engages international students, faculty, and staff.

- 1. Build upon the welcome event VP Jones established for new students by holding a welcome event for new international graduate students and their faculty advisors.
- 2. Continue working with Institutional Diversity to collaborate on jointly sponsored events and support each other's major campus events.
- 3. Work with campus offices to increase the number of campus employment opportunities available to international students.
- 4. Employ social media more effectively with students to connect with and serve them.
- 5. Highlight the fact all international students who have completed their degrees receive a complimentary *Global Citizen* stole to wear to commencement.

Table participants offered the following suggestions for promoting awareness of study abroad programs for Minnesota State Mankato students.

- 1. Survey faculty and staff to determine those persons who have studied abroad and enlist their support in both leading and promoting study abroad programs.
- 2. Work with the Career Development Center to more effectively showcase students' study abroad experiences during their job searches.
- 3. Work with the First Year Experience team, Student Relations Coordinators, and New Student Orientation team to make first year students more aware of the study abroad opportunities available.
- 4. Highlight the fact all students who have completed a study abroad program receive a complimentary *Global Citizen* stole to wear to commencement.
